## ABOUT

The Bridge to the Doctorate (BD) Grant is awarded by the National Science Foundation through the Florida-Georgia Louis Stokes Alliance for Minority Participation (FG-LSAMP) to enhance recruitment and retention of underrepresented minority students in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) disciplines. The BD grant is awarded through a competitive process to institutions for a period of two years. Scholars are selected via an application process and applications are submitted to the Office of Graduate Diversity Initiatives.

- Citizen or permanent resident of the United States.
- Baccalaureate degree earned, or to be earned, at an LSAMP institution.

- Commitment to the pursuit of the Ph.D. in biological sciences, biomedical engineering, chemical engineering, chemistry, civil engineering, computer science, electrical engineering, environmental engineering, materials science, mechanical engineering, or physics and astronomy
- Priority is given to underrepresented minority students.
